3. Thank you to all the tennis community participants who have actively engaged and taken time to attend meetings. We have seen improvements from new benches, light bulbs replaced, trees pruned, cracks filled, nets restored, signs and backboard ordered. And thank you to Parks and Rec for listening, openly communicating, and helping us fulfil these improvements. We still have a ways to go, but we are moving in the positive direction.
4. Next year 2022 begins with lots of opportunity in our horizon. Cedar Falls and Hargraves courts will be completely renovated with money funded from a bond already passed. Work will continue on improving surfaces at Ephesus. Efforts will be made to make courts more inviting for play such as adding more benches and making sure lights are working properly. Depending on funding, improvements are being looked at for Oakwood. In order to guide this work, the tennis community will need to stay organized and guide this work.
5. A meeting will be scheduled in January to talk about our goals and strategy for the upcoming year. New leadership will need to be identified to lead the group,

define initiatives, and schedule the meetings throughout the New Year. Please think about stepping up to keep the good work going!
