1. The New Year 2022 begins with momentum from last year’s tennis court improvements and new opportunities in the horizon.
 - a. Cedar Falls and Hargraves courts will be completely renovated with money funded from a bond already passed. Because of tennis community feedback, six adults will be retained at CF.  - b. Lots of small but noticeable changes at Ephesus have improved the court and made them more inviting and playable. A slanted backboard and court signs are on order. Investigation is on-going for a cost effective noise reducing screen between the PB and tennis courts.
 - c. Plans are underway to resurface Ephesus courts in spring 2022. Courts will have new painted surface with cracks and low areas patched. The plan is to use a material Bamilex recommended by Americourt. The material has a weave like texture to help cover cracks as they return. P&R and tennis community recognize this is only a temporary solution until funding is acquired for a longer term solution.
 - d. Depending on funding, improvements are being looked at for Oakwood. In order to guide this work, the tennis community will need to stay organized and provide input.
