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Survey Results – Tennis & Pickleball User Experiences and Feedback on Potential Shared Use of Outdoor Courts

Dates Survey Accessible On-line: July 8, 2022 through July 25, 2022

Online Survey was advertised through:

- Town of Chapel Hill Parks and Recreation webpage (*specifically the Tennis and Pickleball webpage*)
- Signs at Town of Chapel Hill Parks and Recreation Department outdoor court properties, indoor community centers, and aquatics center.
- Tennis and Pickleball community groups: Friends of Chapel Hill Public Tennis Courts and Chapel Hill Pickleball

INTRODUCTION

The Town of Chapel Hill Parks and Recreation Department is reviewing a proposal submitted by Chapel Hill Pickleball for the shared-usage of (2) of the (4) tennis courts at Ephesus Park. To provide an opportunity for users of the Town Chapel Hill outdoor courts to share their experiences and to express their thoughts on potential shared use of outdoor courts, Parks and Recreation invited outdoor court users to use an online survey.

We recognize that there are limitations to such a survey– for instance, survey technology was not used to prevent individuals from completing more than one survey. We believe that the survey provided an opportunity to gain input from additional users.

HIGHLIGHTS

- 408 total responses
- Self-reported by respondents: 145 tennis players; 230 pickleball players; 33 players who play both sports
- Majority of survey respondents play their respective sport at Ephesus Park
- Mornings and evenings are reported as the most frequent play times for both tennis and pickleball players
- 96% of survey participants reported utilizing Town of Chapel Hill Outdoor Courts within the last three months (*at the time of the survey*)
- Most tennis (76%) and pickleball (95%) players reported they had to wait to access a court to play their respective sport due to courts being full
- Reported usage by respondents shows outdoor courts are utilized daily by both tennis and pickleball players
- Self-reported by respondents: 270 Orange County residents; 138 non-Orange County residents
 - 90% of tennis players participating in the survey identified themselves as Orange County residents; and 10% identified themselves as non-Orange County residents
 - 52% of pickleball players participating in the survey identified themselves as Orange County residents; and 48% identified themselves as non-Orange County residents
- 65% of tennis players and 65% of pickleball players participating in the survey reported that they utilize courts not operated by the Town of Chapel Hill Parks and Recreation to play their respective sport

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- Regarding shared use:
 - 93% of pickleball players completing the survey were interested in the implementation of shared use on the tennis courts
 - 10% of tennis players completing the survey were interested in the implementation of shared use on the tennis courts
 - The above results do not include those who reported playing both sports






2. Within the Town of Chapel Hill, where do you typically play these sports?




3. What day(s) do you typically play tennis?






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7. Have you utilized the play locations, times, and days you mentioned above within the last three months?




