Friends of CH Public Tennis - Update on Sharing Ephesus Tennis Courts

1. Update on Sharing Ephesus Tennis Courts

Atuya Cornwell, CH Parks & Rec interim director, announced in an e-mail last week the loss of another dedicated tennis court at Ephesus.

The P&R staff has approved a pilot (trial) program to prioritize PickleBall play on court 4 of the tennis courts on Wednesday's and Friday's starting this month. PickleBall lines will be drawn on court 4. Two PB nets will be put up on court 4 during these times.

This represents a rejection of the resolution passed unanimously by the PG&R commissioners in a September 2022 meeting to "keep the four tennis courts dedicated to tennis at least until renovations are completed on tennis courts at Cedar Falls" (likely couple years off).
